

Unity Run and Be Kind to your Mind Marathon

On November 1, 2025, at 6:00 AM, Unity run and "Be Kind to Your Mind" themed marathon was organized on the occasion of Uttarakhand Foundation Day under the joint aegis of Gautam Buddha Medical College, Jhajhra, and the affiliated Dr. K.K.B.M.
